The Society's primary income comes from donations, grants, sponsorships and ticket sales to events with secondary income from membership subscriptions.

The Society applies to various organisations and individuals for donations, grants and sponsorships. These are either for a specifc purpose, such as an arts festival, or for the general running of the Society.

# **Statement of Service Performance**

Arrowtown Creative Arts Society Incorporated For the year ended 31 March 2022

### **Description of Entity's Outcomes**

The objectives of the society are:

- To develop the arts in the Arrowtown Community for both ourmembers and the residents of the township and its surrounds.
- To support a wide range of arts activities including visual, performing, literary, and others.
- To provide the community with arts events includingFestivals, Talks, Exhibitions, Workshops, Performances.
- To provide platforms, education, and collegial activities for local artists.
- To make co-ordinated communications available to other artsgroups in the region.
- To lobby for an encourage support from other relevant bodies including local government, and arts groups.
- To engage in any other activities ancillary to the above.

### Description and Quantification of the Entity's Outputs

The Society:

- Operates a Facebook page which provides membership and events information. It also occasionally includes information on events being held by other organisations in the arts space.
- Has a website (www.acas.nz) which provides membership and event information. This website also enables group emails to the membership and provides an easy means of signing up for newsletters and joining the society as a financial member
- Has nine "Benefactors" who have agreed to take on a two year role as benefactors. During the financial year ACAS received \$18,000 from benefactors being the 2021 biennial contribution. This contribution is tax deductible and does not offer any particular reciprocal value or free admission to events.

During the financial year, in the Arrowtown area, the Society:

- Held "A Conversation with Charlotte Grimshaw" presenting this popular NZ author in a relaxed social setting at the Arrowtown Community Centre
- Held an "Art Union II Exhibition" at Lakes District Museum gallery opening on December 2021 until March 2022
- Our biennial Spring Arts Festival was postponed by a year due to COVID restrictions. Planning was completed for over 15 events covering a wide range of the arts. Our application for QLDC community support for this event was withdrawn until the following year
- Supported the opening night of the Queenstown Camera Club exhibition at the Lakes District Museum Gallery on 30 September 2021
- The annual Opera in the Garden event was cancelled within 30 days of the planned date due to COVID restrictions. ACAS applied for and was granted compensation for commitments to performers and sound technicians. \$16,000 was distributed to these recipients during April 2022.
- Presented a performance of Southern Soul at Christmas, a group of local singers covering contemporary songs and carols December 2021.
- Began to receive the services of a paid administrator. Sharon Leamy now assists with event promotions, Facebook updates, website updates and annual subscription invoicing.

### **Additional Output Measures**

The Society has complied with all its obligations under the Charities Act to ensure it continues to maintain its Registered Charity status, which was granted on 20 March 2018.

# **Statement of Accounting Policies**

### Arrowtown Creative Arts Society Incorporated For the year ended 31 March 2022

### 1. Reporting Entity

Arrowtown Creative Arts Society Incorporated is incorporated under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908 and is a Registered Charity.

### 2. Statement of Accounting Policies

### **Basis of Preparation**

The entity has elected to apply PBE SFR-A (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Accrual (Not-For-Profit) on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses equal to or less than \$2,000,000. All transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting and Tier 3 reporting. The Performance Report is prepared under the assumption that the entity will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

### Accounts Receivable

Receivables are stated at their estimated realisable value. Bad debts are written off in the year in which they are identified.

### **Goods and Services Tax**

The entity is not registered for GST. Therefore all amounts are stated inclusive of GST (if any). The Society was de-registered for GST on 31 July 2017.

### Income Tax

As a Registered Charity from 20 March 2018, Arrowtown Creative Arts Society Incorporated is exempt from income tax.

Prior to March 2018 the Society had been been granted a partial exemption by Inland Revenue under section DV8 of the Income Tax Act 2007. The Society claimed a deduction for either \$1,000 or net income after expenses, whichever was the lesser amount.

### **Bank Accounts and Cash**

Bank accounts and cash in the Statement of Cash Flows comprise cash balances and bank balances (including short term deposits) with original maturities of 90 days or less.

#### Revenue

Event revenue from attendances is recognised in the year the income is earned.

Grants received and sponsorship income are recognised in operating revenue when any special conditions attached to the grant have been met. If special conditions have not been met, the grant is treated as a liability until the conditions are met.

Interest is accounted for using the effective method, ie interest is accounted for as it is earned.

Fundraising and other unconditional donations are recognised when received with the exception of donations from benefactors which can be received in advance and these are recognised in the year to which they relate.

#### **Changes in Accounting Policies**

There have been no changes in accounting policies. Policies have been applied on a consistent basis with those of the previous reporting period.
